To Whom It May Concern:

Materials Life Cycle Management Company (MLMC) changed its name to NuCycle Energy on August 21, 2019.

As published in RCRA Online Number 14898 (document date 2018-03-27) and entitled "Non-Hazardous Secondary Materials Name Change", the USEPA was informed that International Paper Products Corporation had changed its name to Materials Lifecycle Management Company.

International Paper Products Corporation, RCRA Online Number 14859 (document date 2011-10-05) was provided a letter from USEPA that indicated

"EPA believes the 40 CFR Part 241 regulations would identify Enviro-Fuelcubes (EFC), composed of non-hazardous raw material feedstocks such as paper and other materials, generated by the International Paper Products Corporation (IPPC) and burned in combustion units as a non-waste fuel."

This section further includes reference to the March 27, 2018 letter informing EPA that International Paper Products Corporation had changed its name to Materials Lifecycle Management Corporation.

We, therefore, request a copy of this letter be published to the RCRA Online portal for Waste Determinations for Combusted Non-Hazardous Secondary Materials with a reference on the RCRAOnline Memo Detail that NuCycle Energy is the new name of the company.
